## U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Ludlow Sand and Gravel Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its fifth five-year review of the **Ludlow Sand and Gravel Superfund Site**, located in the town of Paris, Oneida County, New York. This review seeks to confirm that the cleanup conducted at the site, which included removal of contaminated soil and sediment, placement of a cap over the landfill at the site, solidification of deeper contaminated soil and ongoing long-term groundwater monitoring, continues to be protective of human health and the environment.

Although the Ludlow Sand and Gravel site was deleted from the National Priorities List in December 2013, five-year reviews will continue as needed. A summary of cleanup activities and an evaluation of the protectiveness of the implemented cleanup remedy will be included in the five-year review report.

## What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

The purpose of five-year reviews is to ensure that implemented remedies at Superfund sites function as intended and continue to be protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records; and
- Determination if any new relevant regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.

## When will EPA's Five-Year Review Report be available?

It is anticipated that the five-year review report will be available at the website noted below by May 2019.
